About the Inn

The Inn at Norwood is centrally located in the heart of Historic Sykesville, Maryland. Built in 1906 by the architect J.H. Fowble, The Inn at Norwood is a Colonial Revival home retaining much of its original charm. Mr. Fowble built many of the buildings in the town of Sykesville, but he built the Inn as his family's residence.

Guests can relax on the front porch overlooking the town, or just snuggle up in the parlor with a good book. The Inn has six beautifully decorated guest rooms and one long term stay apartment.



About the Town

Sykesville is a Maryland & National Main Street and National Trust for Historic Preservation District. Our rich history, scenic location along the Patapsco, and our vital Main Street are just a few reasons to visit. We also have spring/summer concerts as well as festivals, a 1949 twelve-gauge train ride, model train exhibits located inside real locomotive cars, and much more.

Accommodations

All seven guest rooms all have private baths with Jetted tubs, cable TV/DVD's, fireplaces, air conditioning, refrigerators, and wireless internet.

Summer Room

The Summer Room (2nd floor) is beautifully decorated and reminiscent of being at a summer cottage. The room contains a queen size canopy bed, Jetted tub with a shower and an electric fireplace.

Spring Room

The Spring Room (2nd floor) is decorated in lovely pastels. This Room has a queen-size romantic carved bed, a day bed, an electric fireplace, as a Jetted tub and a two-headed rain shower.

Fall Room

The Fall Room (2nd floor) is decorated in spectacular autumn colors. Escape to the mountains and enjoy the cast iron gas fireplace, the Victorian queen size bed, walk-in shower, and the 2-person Jetted tub.

Winter Room

The Winter Room (2nd floor) is our most romantic room. Decorated in warm inviting colors. The room contains an exquisite queen sized 4 post canopy bed, walk-in shower, 2-person Jetted tub, and a fabulous gas fireplace.

Secret Garden Room

The Secret Garden Room is directly outside the main house on the ground level, giving you a private entrance to your romantic escape. This room has an Iron queen sized bed, our largest 2-person Jetted Tub, an electric fireplace, a wet bar with a refrigerator, a microwave, a coffee maker and individually controlled heat and air.

The Loft

The Loft (2nd floor) is the Inn's largest luxury suite, located behind the main house. Lose yourself in the king-sized Mahogany bed, sit quietly on your private deck or watch the roaring 3-sided fireplace from your large 2-person Jetted tub. This room is complete with a wet bar, refrigerator, a microwave, a coffee maker, a day bed, and individually controlled heat and air.

The Cottage – Our Long Term Stay Apartment

The Cottage is the Inn's newest addition located outside the main house, on the 2nd Floor, above the Secret Garden Room. This 1 Bedroom Apartment is decorated in Old World Charm. It has a queen bed, a day bed, an electric fireplace, a large Jetted tub, a two-headed shower, 2 TV's (1 in the bedroom and 1 in the living room), and a DVD Player, and individually controlled heat and air. This room is the only room with a full kitchen and a washer and dryer. It is only available for Long Term Stays of 2 weeks or longer.

Directions

From Interstate 695 & I-70:

Take the Baltimore Beltway 695 to I-70 West Frederick (exit #16), take I-70 to exit #80 MD-52 North Sykesville, turn right coming off the exit, go approximately 3.5 miles then turn left at sign Sykesville - Main Street, go 1/2 mile and make the 3rd left which is Church Street, the house is straight ahead of you, turn right onto Norwood Avenue and a quick left to the parking lot in the rear.
